



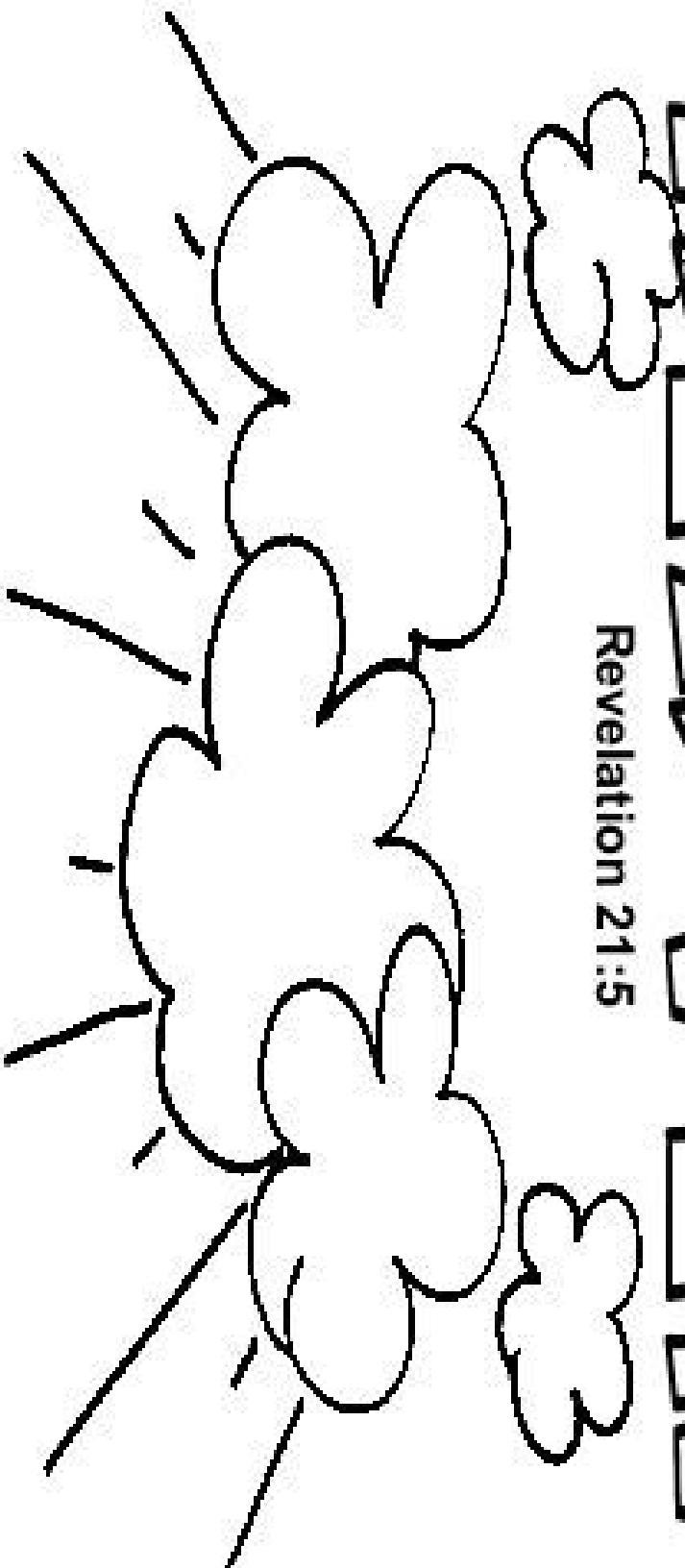

Questions and Conversation Starters:

- Jesus came back from the dead and is alive in Heaven now! Followers of Jesus can be excited that we will get to go to Heaven too! Let's review what Heaven will be like. Say Yes or No if the following things will be a part of Heaven:
 - Sickness (no)
 - Joy (yes)
 - God (yes)
 - Tear and sadness (no)
 - Death (no)
 - Fear (no)
 - Laughter (yes)
- what is the best gift you've ever received? Just imagine how much greater a gift is getting to go to Heaven! Jesus' death made it possible for you to have that greatest gift! How does that make you feel?

Activities:

- The Empty Tomb
 - Print the worksheet so each child has a copy.
 - Allow kids to collect the listed materials and fill in the sheet like a "color-by-numbers" except that the numbers/colors are natural materials found outside.
 - Take a picture of their finished tomb pictures to keep through the year.
- Jelly Bean Prayer

- You'll need a bowl of jelly beans.
- As you distribute a single jelly bean of each color to the kids, tell them what that color represents (omit or replace colors that are not available in your candy mix).
 - Black is for the wrong we do
 - Purple is for the sadness that Jesus faced on the Cross
 - Red is for the sacrifice Jesus made- his own blood
 - white is for the grace and forgiveness we can receive
 - Green is for the life of growth we can have following Jesus
 - Yellow is for the future glory in Heaven
