Lesson Summary:

- Paul and Barnabas traveled around telling all people about Jesus. Paul explained that Jesus died so that all people could be forgiven. Paul explained that this forgiveness was a gift called grace. Many people believed in Jesus and followed Jesus because of Paul. Peter also taught people about Jesus and free grace, but... one day, some people visited who thought that God's grace wasn't free. These people taught that people had to obey rules to be forgiven. Peter wanted these people to like him, so he didn't correct them. Peter even stopped hanging out with anyone who didn't follow the rules. Paul saw what Peter was doing. Paul told Peter that he was wrong. Paul reminded Peter that God's forgiveness is FREE. Paul reminded Peter that no one needs to follow rules to be forgiven. Paul was brave to fight for the truth! Jesus is all we need to be forgiven.
